WEEKEND REVIEW

In the Premier Division, two goals in the final minute ensured that leaders Dover Athletic collected a point against Carshalton Athletic at the Perrys Crabble. The Robins made it 2–1 before the Whites snatched a point, which saw their lead at the top of the table cut to “just” 18 points, and it was the end of their perfect home record. Staines Town also left it late, but their 88th-minute goal proved the winner, 2–1, at home to Canvey Island. Tonbridge Angels lost ground on the top two with a goalless draw at Horsham. At the bottom of the table, Harrow

Borough, Ramsgate and Harlow Town all recorded vital victories, 2–1 at Boreham Wood, 3–2 at home to Heybridge Swifts and 2–1 at Wealdstone, respectively. With Hendon coming back from 2–0 down to earn a point at home to Tooting & Mitcham United, it means Swifts are now five points adrift at the bottom and 10 points from safety. Hendon are three points behind Borough and Margate – who drew 1–1 at Hastings United – and five from safety. Dartford are now in the playoff spots after their 2–0 victory at home to Billericay Town at the expense of Sutton United, who threw away a two goal lead at home to Maidstone United and had to settle for a 2–2 draw. Ashford Town (Middlesex) won 3–1 at AFC Hornchurch.

Aveley are now four points clear at the top of Division One North after a 4–3 victory at home to Chatham Town. East Thurrock United, Brentwood Town and Northwood all kept up the pressure with victories, the Rocks downing Great Wakering Rovers 3–0, Brentwood beating Ware 2–0 and Northwood winning 2–1 at Cheshunt. At the bottom of the table, Hillingdon Borough suffered another big home defeat, 4–0 to Leyton, but Witham Town had a massive victory (in terms of importance) as they overcame Ilford 1–0. Witham are now just a point behind Waltham Forest. The other two matches to go ahead ended in 3–0 scorelines, Concord Rangers overcoming Thamesmead Town at Thames Road and

Tilbury doing likewise at Maldon Town. For promotion-chasing Waltham Abbey and Wingate & Finchley there was frustration as their matches – at home to Potters Bar Town and away to Waltham Forest, respectively – were postponed, as was Redbridge's encounter with Enfield Town.

There were five draws in Division One South. The game of the day was at Imber Court, where second-placed Metropolitan Police could have gone top with a victory over leaders Kingstonian. Instead they ended the day in fourth place despite avoiding defeat – testimony to the tightness of the race in the division. In fact, just three points separate the top six teams and eighth-placed Merstham are two wins off top spot. Ks led twice, but the Blues came back on both occasions to share the spoils. Cray Wanderers were 3–0 winners at home to Burgess Hill Town and Worthing won 1–0 at Walton & Hersham, but for the other playoff team, Ashford Town, there was frustration as they drew 1–1 at Sittingbourne. Crowborough Athletic's long losing run continues as they slumped 4–2 at home to Chipstead, but there was a much bigger defeat for Corinthian-Casuals – 6–0 at home to Walton Casuals. Chipstead and Walton Casuals both moved above Corinthian-Casuals in the bottom four. Leatherhead ended Fleet Town's recent charge with a 2–0 win at Stompond Lane. There was a thriller at Merstham, where the home team trailed 1–0, led 3–1 and eventually hung on for a 4–3 victory against Eastbourne Town. In the other three draws, there were no goals at Church Road, where Whyteleafe entertained Whitstable Town, two at Croydon Athletic, where Folkestone Invicta scored after just 16 seconds, and four at Dulwich Hamlet, as the hosts equalised in the final minute to deny Godalming Town.

Premier Division

Fourth-placed Carshalton Athletic travelled to leaders Dover Athletic with an unbeaten record, to play a team with a perfect 14-for-14 home mark, so something had to give. In the end it was Dover, who now boast only an unbeaten home record. A Frannie Collin penalty after 59 minutes gave the Whites the lead, but Barry Stevens equalised 13 minutes later. As the game moved into stoppage time, Lewis Gonsalves gave the Robins the lead, but Jerahl Hughes save a point for the table-toppers. Staines Town were indebted to Howard Newton's 88th-minute goal to take all three points from Canvey Island, who have now lost two League matches at Wheatsheaf

Park in five weeks (Hendon played their home game against the Gulls at the same venue in mid-January). Scott Taylor gave Staines the lead after 12 minutes, but Richard Halle equalised just past the half-hour mark before the late drama.

Tonbridge Angels played out a goalless draw at Horsham and stay third, while goals from Brendon Cass, 71 minutes, and John Guest, 80, were enough to give Dartford a 2–0 victory over Billericay Town and lift them into the last of the playoff places. Two goals from Gavin McCullum, after 8 and 58 minutes, seemed to have set up Sutton United for a home victory against Maidstone United, but the Kent club pulled a goal back through Lloyd Blackman's penalty after 67 minutes and they completed the comeback with a goal from Mesach Nugent in the last five minutes.

Another Surrey club, Tooting & Mitcham United, spurned a two-goal lead and had to settle for a share of the points. Aaron Goode, 14 minutes, and Michael Antonio, 41, had put them in the driving seat at Hendon, but Andrew Howell's 53rd-minute own goal, breathed life into the Greens and James Parker rescued a point for Hendon near the end. A see-saw clash at Southwood Stadium saw Ramsgate boost their survival chances at the expense of basement club Heybridge Swifts. Stefan Ball gave the Rams an early lead, but two goals in two minutes from James Robinson, 33 and 35, saw Swifts lead at the break. George Purcell equalised with 11 minutes to go and Jay May's 84th-minute penalty won it for Ramsgate. Harlow Town also trailed before winning 2–1 at Wealdstone, but Shaun Gliddon's equaliser came in the 11th minute, barely 60 seconds after Lee Chappell had opened the scoring for the hosts. Harlow's match-winner was Sam Berry, who scored with 13 minutes to go.

Lee Hall and Warren Whiteley scored two minutes before and two minutes after half-time in Harrow Borough's 2–1 victory at Boreham Wood. Jon Clements scored for Woods in the final minute. Luke Wheatley gave Margate the lead after 19 minutes at Hastings United, but Rhys Whyborne levelled matters after 31 minutes and it ended 1–1. And last, and by no means, least, the Premier Division's only hat-trick was accomplished by Byron Harrison of Ashford Town (Middlesex) in their 3–1 victory at AFC Hornchurch. He scored after 19, 43 and 81 minutes; Mark Janney netted for the Urchins early in the second half.

Division One North

There was a ding-dong encounter at Millfield where leaders Aveley finally prevailed 4–3 over Chatham Town, Lee Barnett gave the Chats the lead after four minutes, but Petrit Elbi equalised from the penalty spot six minutes later. Neil Richmond made it 2–1 to the Millers and Elbi's second, early in the second half, seemed to be enough. But back came Chatham and Brad Potter and Barnett, again, scored after 62 and 63 minutes to level things up. Parity lasted just three minutes as Richmond became the third player with a brace, and it proved to be the match-winner. Max Cornhill went one better than the trio at Millfield, bagging a hat-trick for East Thurrock United as they defeated Great Wakering Rovers 3–0 at Rookery Hill. His goals came after 29, 41 and 70 minutes. Brentwood Town round out the top three after their 2–0 home victory against Ware, Gary Henty, 44 minutes, and Sherwin Stanley, 74, scoring the goals.

Northwood are up to fourth after Lee Matthews' 84th-minute penalty earned a 2–1 victory at Cheshunt. Anthony Page gave the Woods the lead after 29 minutes, while Kai Ramshaw equalised for the Ambers. Concord Rangers are two points outside the playoff places after Gary Cook, Elliot Buchanan and Michael Begg scored within 14 second half minutes as they enjoyed a 3–0 home win against Thamesmead Town. Tilbury were also 3–0 victors, the Dockers triumphing at Maldon Town thanks to Chris Stowe, 32 minutes, Zubair Hakeem, 70, and Joe Keith, 88.

At the bottom of the table, Witham Town picked up three vital points courtesy of Tommy Robinson's 70th-minute goal against fellow strugglers Ilford. Witham are just five points behind the Foxes, but, more importantly, nine clear of Hillingdon Borough, who went down 4–0 at home to Leyton. Des Thomas scored twice for Leyton after one and 20 minutes, Daniel Gabriel and Michael Bakare, getting the other two. The other three matches were postponed.

Division One South

Bobby Traynor converted penalties after 15 and 54 minutes to give Kingstonian two leads against Metropolitan Police at Imber Court, Michael Cobden, 25 minutes, and Gary Drewett, 85, netted equalizers as the game ended 2–2. Cray Wanderers moved level on points with the Ks as Richmond Kissi (who else on Valentine's Day), 39 minutes, and Lewis Wood, 75 and 84, scored in their 3–0 defeat of Burgess Hill Town. Ashford Town

are third after a 1–1 draw at Sittingbourne. Orlando Smith gave them the lead early in the second half, but Richard Brady earned a point for the Brickies after 76 minutes.

In one of two games of great importance at the bottom of the table, 22nd-placed Crowborough Athletic took on Chipstead, 21st, and the basement-dwellers' recent dismal form continued. The Crows' 14th consecutive League defeat saw them equalise twice, Craig Bishop, 14 minutes, and Chris Ransome, 74 (a penalty), cancelling out efforts from Gavin Quintyne, nine minutes, and Liam Oxley, 26. But Aaron Cole-Bolt scored after 80 and 90 minutes for the Chips to bring them the points. In the other Corinthian–Casuals, who started the day 19th, lost 6–0 at home to Walton Casuals, who are now in that position, for whom Paul Armstrong, five and 75 minutes, Michael Barima, 53 and 79, and Luke Roodenburg, 84 and 89, all scored twice.

Worthing are back in the top five after a solitary goal at Walton & Hersham. A long throw from Ross Treleven after 34 minutes bobbed around in the penalty before going into the goal, with either the Rebels' Jamie Brotherton or the Swans' Jon Boswell getting the final touch. Fleet Town dropped out of the playoff places with their 2–0 defeat at Leatherhead, Tony Cuff, 20 minutes, and Steve Goddard, 78, scoring for the Tanners. In a storming game at Moatside, Merstham defeated Eastbourne Town by the odd goal in seven. The hosts never trailed, first taking the lead through Kevin Lock after 18 minutes. Jamie Salvidge equalised two minutes before half-time, but Merstham hit back immediately, Gavin Gordon restoring their lead within a minute. Lock, again, and Matt Francis stretched the advantage to three goals and although James Norwood pulled one goal back after 76 minutes and Peter Cooper another four minutes later to set up a grandstand finish, Town couldn't get a fourth goal.

Folkestone Invicta scored after just 16 seconds, the prolific James Dryden netting, on their visit to Croydon Athletic. But they had to settle for a point after Reece Wilson equalised with 15 minutes to go. Laurent Hamici gave Dulwich Hamlet the lead after 24 minutes at home Godalming Town. Graeme Purdy equalised early in the second and Shawn Beveney gave the visitors the lead with just nine minutes to go. In stoppage time, Daniel Francis rescued a point for Hamlet. The day's fifth draw in the division had no goal,

Whyteleafe and Whitstable Town playing out an entertaining draw at Church Road.
